

ARE YOUR "ORGANIC" BODY CARE PRODUCTS FOR REAL?



When a Product Says "Organic," Be Sure to Look for Certification!

Unfortunately, many body care products that are marketed as "Organic" aren't certified to USDA Organic standards and contain many ingredients that would never be allowed under the USDA's National Organic Program.

To identify true organic body care, look for the USDA seal (for products that are >95% organic) or the words "Made with Organic Ingredients" and the seal of a USDA accredited organic certifier (for products that are >70% organic).
