"Agriculture currently accounts for 10 percent [editor's note: it is actually much higher than this] of the United States' greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions. Within agriculture, the largest source of GHG emissions are industrial farming practices that degrade soil health, pollute waterways, and harm biodiversity, followed by industrial animal production at confined animal feeding operations. Industrial agriculture is part of the climate problem. Regenerative agriculture, on the other hand, provides a path for agriculture to be part of the climate solution. Regenerative agriculture, a land management philosophy that focuses on farming and ranching in harmony with nature, presents a contrast to the dominant industrial agricultural model. By using principles and practices that build soil health, regenerative farmers and ranchers sequester carbon, clean waterways, and protect wildlife.

### **Wuhan Lab Can Delete Data in 'Explosive' Legal Agreement With U.S. Lab**

"The Wuhan Institute of Virology has the right to ask a partnering lab in the U.S. to destroy all records of their work, according to a legal document obtained by U.S. Right to Know. A memorandum of understanding between the Wuhan lab and the Galveston National Laboratory at the University of Texas Medical Branch states that each lab can ask the other to return or 'destroy' any so-called 'secret files' — any communications, documents, data or equipment resulting from their collaboration — and ask that they wipe any copies.

"Households are some of the biggest contributors to food waste in the United States, according to research from ReFED.

The organization reports that households generate 30 million surplus food tons, or 37 percent, of all food waste in the U.S. Almost half ended up in landfills, where it emits harmful greenhouse gases that contribute to the climate crisis.

"The number one source of food going to waste is actually us, consumers, all 329 million of us in our homes, letting food go bad in our homes, not managing it well," says Dana Gunders, Executive Director of ReFED.

Thankfully, there are steps that everyone can take to tackle this problem, starting in their own homes. Through better shopping habits or experimentation in the kitchen, it is possible to cut food waste and support the health of the environment."

### **Fake Meat Will Not Solve the Climate Crisis**

Civil Eats reports: "Meat and dairy are increasingly under the world's microscope as livestock—which rely on huge quantities of feed crops and occupy nearly 80 percent of global farmland—accounts for between 14 percent and 30 percent of global greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions. It's also the source of more frequent antimicrobial-resistant pathogens, and much of the global livestock and seafood industries have been exposed for unsafe and abusive working conditions.

This complex web of problems requires more than one answer. And yet "alternative proteins"—from plant-based to lab-grown "fake" meat and dairy—are being promoted as a simple solution...These products are being sold as a "win-win-win" for animals, people, and the planet. According to Patrick Brown, the outspoken CEO of Impossible Foods, livestock is 'the most destructive technology on earth,' and meat substitutes are 'the last chance to save the planet.'"
